#### ABOUT US

The Embracing Project is a Rite of Passage program made up of free services, with a mission to promote peace and healing for children and youth victims and survivors of sexual exploitation, sex trafficking, and violence. We achieve this through the development of specialized programs, trauma-informed care, and unconditional support.

Dr. Alexis Kennedy highlighted, in a report on Clark County's experience with Commercially Sexually Exploited Youth (CSEC), The Embracing Project as a majority provider of advocacy services to the CSEC population of Clark County, serving 89% of the 202 youth determined to be Sexually Exploited Youth by the courts. The Embracing Project has the *only* drop-in center for CSEC in Las Vegas.

### **ADVOCACY**

Providing case management, court-advocacy, crisis intervention, material & food assistance, programming, and service referrals.

### COUNSELING

Connecting youth & families to support groups, individual, group & family therapy, as well as individual trauma therapy.

### **EDUCATION**

In partnership with Clark County School District Department of Adult Education, and Nevada Learning Academy, youth may attend school at an intensive and individualized pace and focus.
