#### Minutes

### Meeting Content:

- 1. Welcome and introductions were made
- 2. Meeting minutes from 3/10/14 were reviewed
  - a. Asked if there were any questions about the minutes from the last meeting
- 3. Discussed Identification (ID) cards
  - a. Looks like they are ready to go
  - b. Policy has been written and we are in the design phase
  - c. Back of the card will include something regarding what medical decisions are appropriate for the foster parents to give permission for
  - d. Barbara Straight got the software donated
    - It's the same software that the school district uses to take school photos of students
  - e. This will be a two phase process
    - i. First phase the ID card will be printed on card stock as we don't have the money in the budget right now for plastic
    - ii. The cards will be made of hard plastic in the next phase
    - iii. Licensing will take photos when they come to sign their home study for the first phase of implementation
    - iv. Second phase will be done on the next home visit by the case worker
  - f. Dedicated computer and printer will be purchased for next year for one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and the plastic cards for five hundred (\$500)
  - g. Department of Family Services (DFS) hopes is to have this up and running prior to the Implementation Team Meeting on May 13, 2014
  - h. Asked how the agency homes will be able to get the id cards
    - i. Since they are licensed through DFS it will be the same process
      but will include the agency name on the card

- Discussed that on the renewal home visit only one (1) of the parents needs to be present
  - This might create an issue with regard to taking photos of everyone
  - ii. This will be something that will be a personal motivational item
- j. The cards will serve as a way to identify the foster parent as having rights with regard to the child
- 4. Denise Parker, Quality Parenting Initiative (QPI) coordinator, has been to several of the agencies and met many of our families
  - a. She has seen an increase in the numbers of foster families that are getting involved with QPI and decision making
  - b. Foster parents need to be heard
  - c. Denise is asking for ideas for how to motivate parents to get involved
  - d. The statewide Normalcy Meeting has increased by several people as a result of Denise spreading the word to caregivers
    - This just shows that there are lots of different ways for the parents to get involved
- 5. Creation of a quarterly mix and mingle was suggested:
  - a. Separated by zip code areas
  - b. Possible Continuing Education Unit trainings (CEUs) available
  - c. People available to answer questions about relicensing
  - d. Additional trainings as well as ones featuring CEUs
  - e. Meeting would allow caregivers to meet others in their area
  - f. Could be an information sharing opportunity
  - g. May be good to pair with the school supply hand out events already in the works
  - h. Could use the gym at Child Haven
  - i. Could have the associations there as well to help boost caregiver participation in associations

- j. Possibly held in a town hall format
- k. Mentioned that to boost attendance, we can have it be paired with something that we are providing for the families
- I. When things change at DFS, we need to have a way to communicate that to the families
- m. This should be rolled out by the time we hand out school supplies
- 6. Discussed the role communication plays in making sure we can keep our families
  - a. The partnership between workers and families is going to play a big role in helping with communication
  - b. Email addresses will become very important in terms of information sharing
- 7. Suggested having upper management record videos advertising upcoming events and make it fun
- 8. Flyer will be crafted announcing the upcoming survey will be available for Thursday's Easter egg hunt
- 9. Discussed the overload at Child Haven
  - a. Currently there are
    - i. Twelve (12) kids there under the age of two (2)
    - ii. Seventeen (17) kids there under the age of four (4)
  - b. Twenty-eight (28) kids were picked up last night
  - c. Over one thousand (1,000) beds are currently open according to the report
  - d. Fifty percent (50%) of the beds are not really available
  - e. Upper management has a skewed belief that they have enough homes
  - f. We need to have accurate numbers to know what we need to be recruiting for
- 10. There will be a meeting with DFS Licensing regarding adoption only homes
  - a. Denise will be crafting a drilled down list of our families
  - b. Adoption only homes will be handed off to the adoption group

- c. Two (2) lists will be created
  - i. One (1) with adoptions only
  - ii. One (1) with a list of families that will foster but also want to adopt
  - iii. This will create a master list for our adoptions group
- d. We need to exhaust our local resources before going out of state for adoptive homes
- 11. Discussed the April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 Spring Celebration & Foster Connection event:
  - a. Sixty (60) families were recruited for DFS per Oscar Benevides
  - b. Thirty (30) families were recruited for agencies per agency representatives present today
  - c. DFS needs to advertise more in the future
  - d. DFS needs to have something that goes on all the time so people get used to knowing and expecting us to be there much like the farmers market that was a part of this event
  - e. Mentioned that because agenda was released for the Spring Celebration early, people only showed up for specific events throughout the day and didn't stop by the tables

#### 12. Discussed events

- a. Easter Egg Hunt
- b. Walk me Home
  - i. Only about five hundred (500) people showed up to walk
- c. Wag the Tail
- d. Family Fun Day
  - Six or seven (6 or 7) families expressed interest in becoming licensed
- e. Four (4) events will be on April 26, 2014
  - i. Las Vegas Fifty-Ones (51s) event for Clark County Employees
  - ii. Pinwheels Event for the prevention of abuse

- iii. Community Providers event
- iv. Children's Festival
- f. Concerts in the park are coming in May
- g. Parenting Expo is coming up in May at the Cashman center
  - i. The Expo is supposed to bring in thousands of families
- h. Puerto Rican event in May
- i. Event at Nellis Air Force Base is being planned
- Announced the Market Segmentation project has been approved and we are moving forward
  - a. Data wise we have developed the description for what is a quality parent
    - i. Licensed for at least two (2) years
    - ii. Have had at least one (1) child in their home in the last two (2) years
    - iii. Have had no complaints substantiated
  - b. We have identified over eight hundred (800) families that meet the criteria
  - c. If we expand the criteria, we have around fifteen hundred (1500) families
  - d. Next steps involve the work group setting up a sight visit
  - e. Should start in early summer and get results in the late summer or early fall
- 14. Discussed marketing tools
  - As soon as Ka-Boom is finished we will be pushing forward on producing marketing tools
    - i. Tools will include business cards and tool kit
  - b. We won't be waiting until the logo is approved
  - c. We need them prior to when the back to school supplies are distributed
  - d. We have lots of shirts, but they can only be used while on duty
- 15. The Mayor of Henderson met with a work group member last week regarding foster parenting

- a. Henderson holds lots of events, many of them family oriented
- b. The mayor is interested in having a dialogue with DFS about fostering
- c. Suggested that representatives of the work group meet with him in September
- 16. Announced Starbucks is interested in partnering with us for events
  - Information about how to contact them will be passed along to the
    Communications work group and Licensing
