SCHOOL IS BACK IN SESSION

As the summer days wane and the backto-school season approaches, students across the country prepare for a new academic year. For children in foster care, this transition can come with unique challenges and opportunities. While the excitement of new classrooms, teachers, and friends is shared by all students, those in foster care often face additional hurdles that can impact their educational experience. Many youth experience frequent moves that destabilizes their educational potential. This can be emotionally taxing and children begin to lose out on the excitement of that first school day. Many foster youth also require support while in school They may have a Individual Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan. They may have educational needs that have yet to be identified that you will play a part in supporting. It is therefore so important for foster parents to be involved in youth and their schooling.

You are encouraged to get to know your youth's teacher and schooling. Ensure you are connected with student support services or the Students in Transition office that provides resources and support for youth in foster care. Welcome back to school & thanks for fostering with us!

Wesley 15 YEARS OLD This young man enjoys sports, music, and outdoor activities.


